INSTRUCTIONS

Supplies:

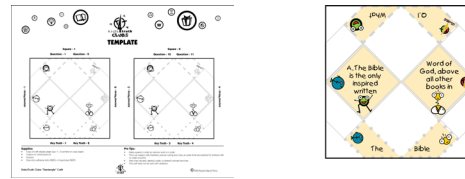
- Copy of craft display pages (pp. 1–3) printed on copy paper

Directions:

- Give each child craft template pages (pp. 1–3).
- Following instructions on template page, add memory work across boxes/diamonds with characters or logos (some numbering is odd):
 - **Dashed boxes** - Kids4Truth Clubs curriculum question.
 - **Dotted boxes** - Kids4Truth Clubs doctrinal-theme key truth.
 - **Double-line diamond boxes** - Kids4Truth Clubs answer with Bible verse.
- Decorate each square and cut out pages along the solid black line.
- Fold and assemble 6 squares as directed in the right column.



Fold and assemble all squares (fold lines are all lines in gray):

1. Fold square in half with printed graphics facing out and open. Rotate square 90 degrees. Fold in half the other way and open.
2. With graphics facing out, rotate page so that it is a diamond. Fold each corner to the center, and open.
3. Fold each corner to first folded line, keep folded, and fold up on line as well to form a tiny box.
4. Flip square over so that “box” faces the table, and graphics are facing you. Rotate so that the square sits as a diamond in front of you.
5. Fold each corner so that all the corners meet in the center, forming a square again.
6. Flip so that “box” shows again and is rotated as a diamond shape.
7. Pulling side “box ends” of diamond outward, gently pull until upper and lower box corners meet, forming an upside down paper hat.
8. Open, rotate, and repeat, leaving “box ends” slightly expanded.
9. Turn square to create a heart by meeting the graphics together and allowing only non-graphic sides to show. Press firmly, ensuring point is nice and neat.
10. Repeat all steps on all squares until you have a total of 6 squares.
11. Arrange squares in order, making sure that the same character is in the upper corners on the same side of the heart as you glue hearts together.
12. Once all 6 hearts are glued together, glue right side of heart 6 (square 6) to left side of heart 1.
