


















- Copy of craft pages (pp. 1–10) printed on copy paper
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Glue stick, adhesive dots (8620), or liquid glue (8629)

Pro Tips:

- Keep squares in order so memory work is in order.
- This is an origami craft; therefore, precise cutting and crisp, accurate folds are essential for finished craft to rotate smoothly.
- Gray lines indicate fold lines.
- This craft does not do well with cardstock.
- Craft pages are provided for all 10 questions of a doctrinal theme. If desired, spread distribution of the 10 question pages over the weeks you study the theme, adding to the cube chain weekly.

Directions:


- Give each child craft template pages (pp. 1–10).
- Add answer with Bible verse across boxes/diamonds with characters or logos on each craft question page in this order:




- Decorate each square and cut out pages along the solid black line.
- Fold and assemble 20 squares as directed in the right column.




INSTRUCTIONS
















Fold and assemble all squares (fold lines are all lines in gray):

- 1. Fold square in half with printed graphics facing out and and open. Rotate square 90 degrees. Fold in half the other way and open.
- 2. Rotate so that square is a diamond and gray lines are sitting horizontally. Fold along the first gray line and then again to the center along the second gray line.
- Repeat on the other side.
- 4. Fold point on the left to inverted point on the right (see dots in illustration) and open.
- 5. Fold point on the right to inverted point on the left (see dots in illustration). Keep folded.
- 6. Anchoring lower right corner, fold bottom edge of right side to align with right folded side.
- Repeat, doing the same with the upper left side by anchoring the upper left corner and folding the top edge to align with the left side.
- Repeat steps 1–7 with the second square on the same craft page. With folded squares side by side, flip the one on the right upside down so that the folds do not show.
- Slightly, open up the folded edges.
- 10. With folded edges of the left square open, insert the right square inside the left square, sliding the edges of the left square into the folds of the right square.
- 11. Fold down the tips.
- 12. Keeping the question on front upper left corner, glue the folded flaps on one cube to the next cube, keeping your cubes in question order.
- 13. Glue the front and back covers to the outside of the first and last cubes.

























