

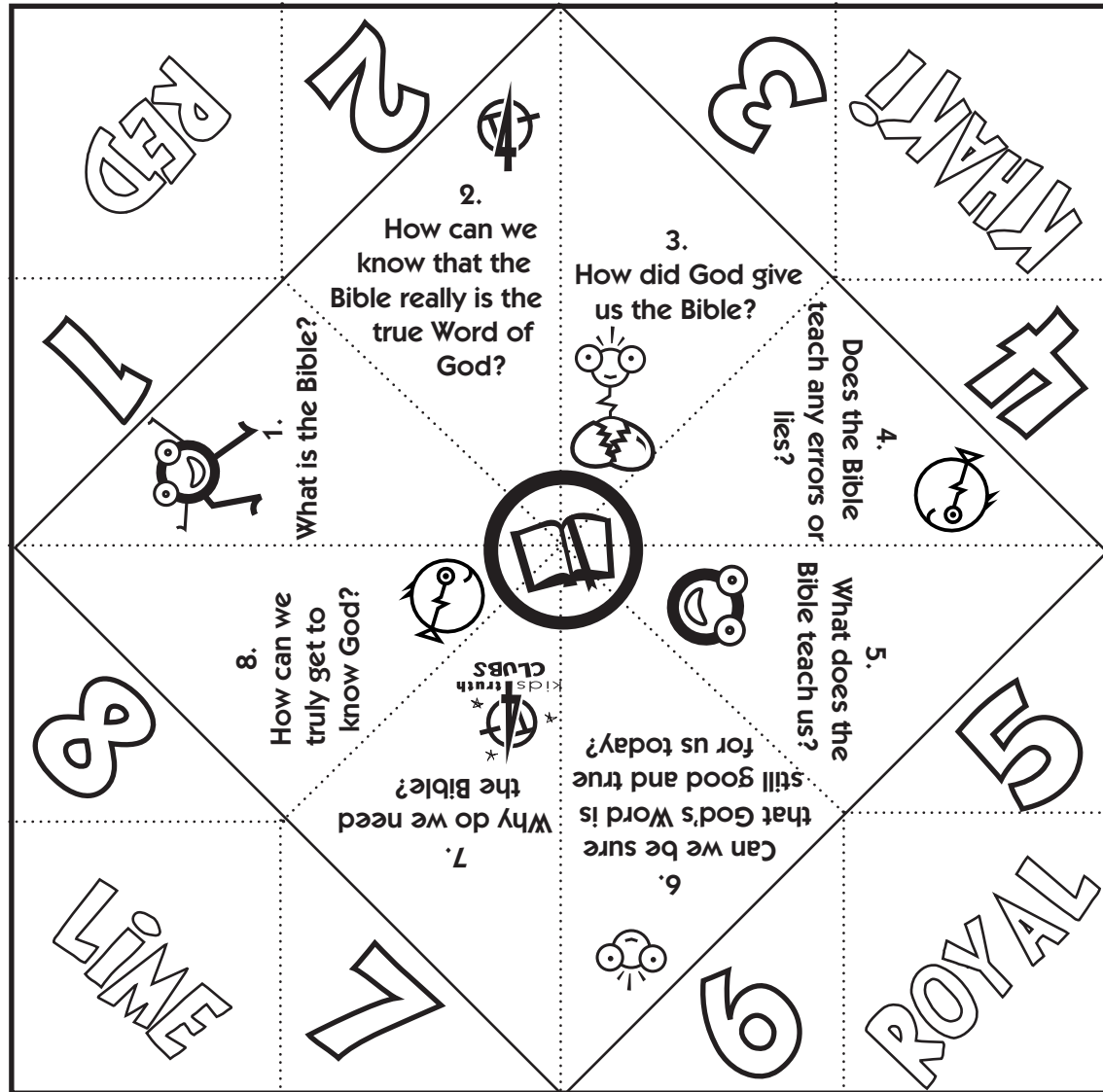


Supplies:

Instructions:

1. Color the design.
2. Cut out the design along the heavy solid lines.
3. Fold along solid lines, meeting all four corners in the center.
4. Flip design over and fold all four corners to the center again.
5. Fold entire piece in half and then fold in half the other way so that you have a square.
6. Unfold last two folds and slide fingers in the flaps on the back that are labeled Lime, Red, Khaki, and Royal.

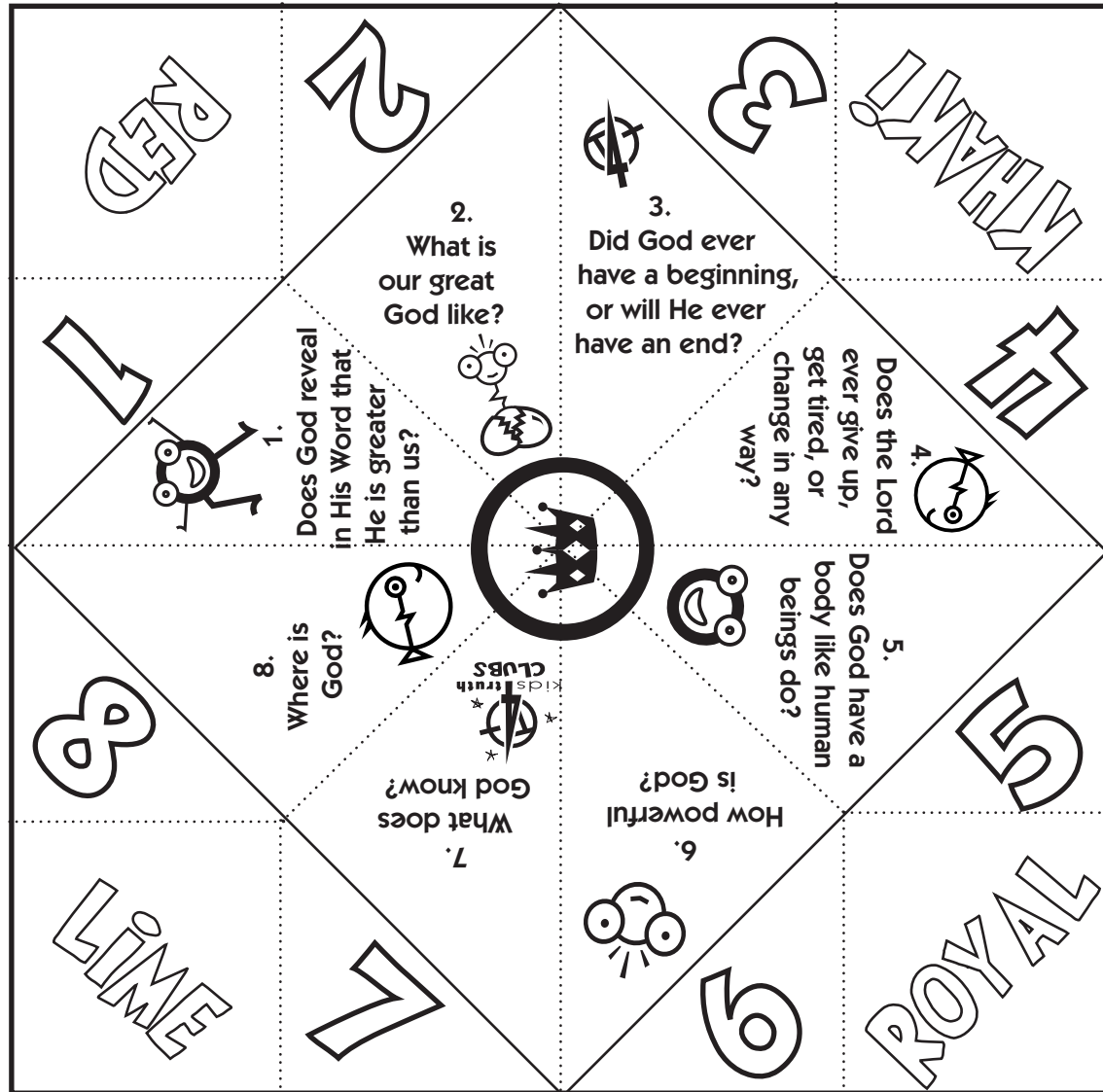

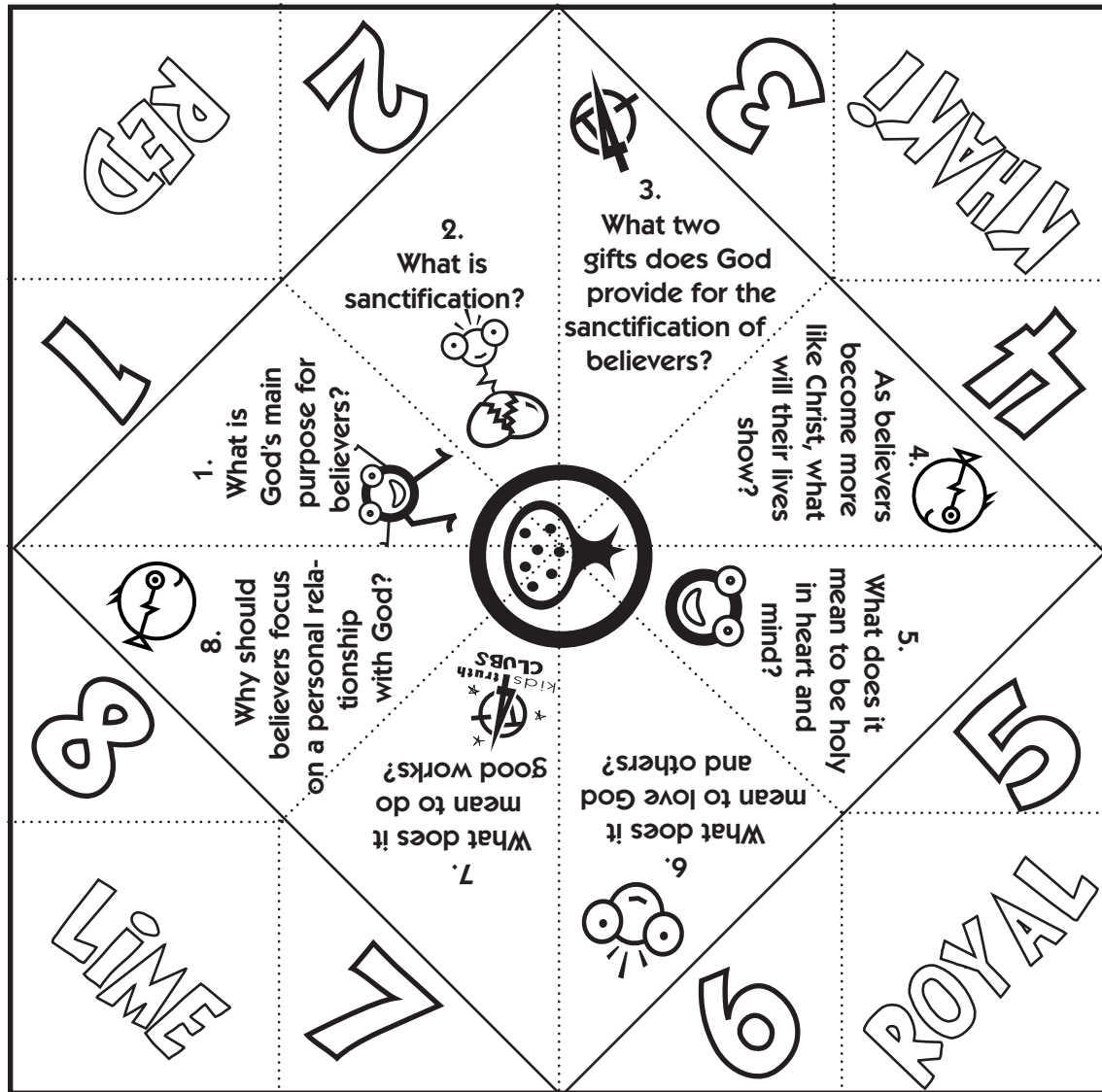

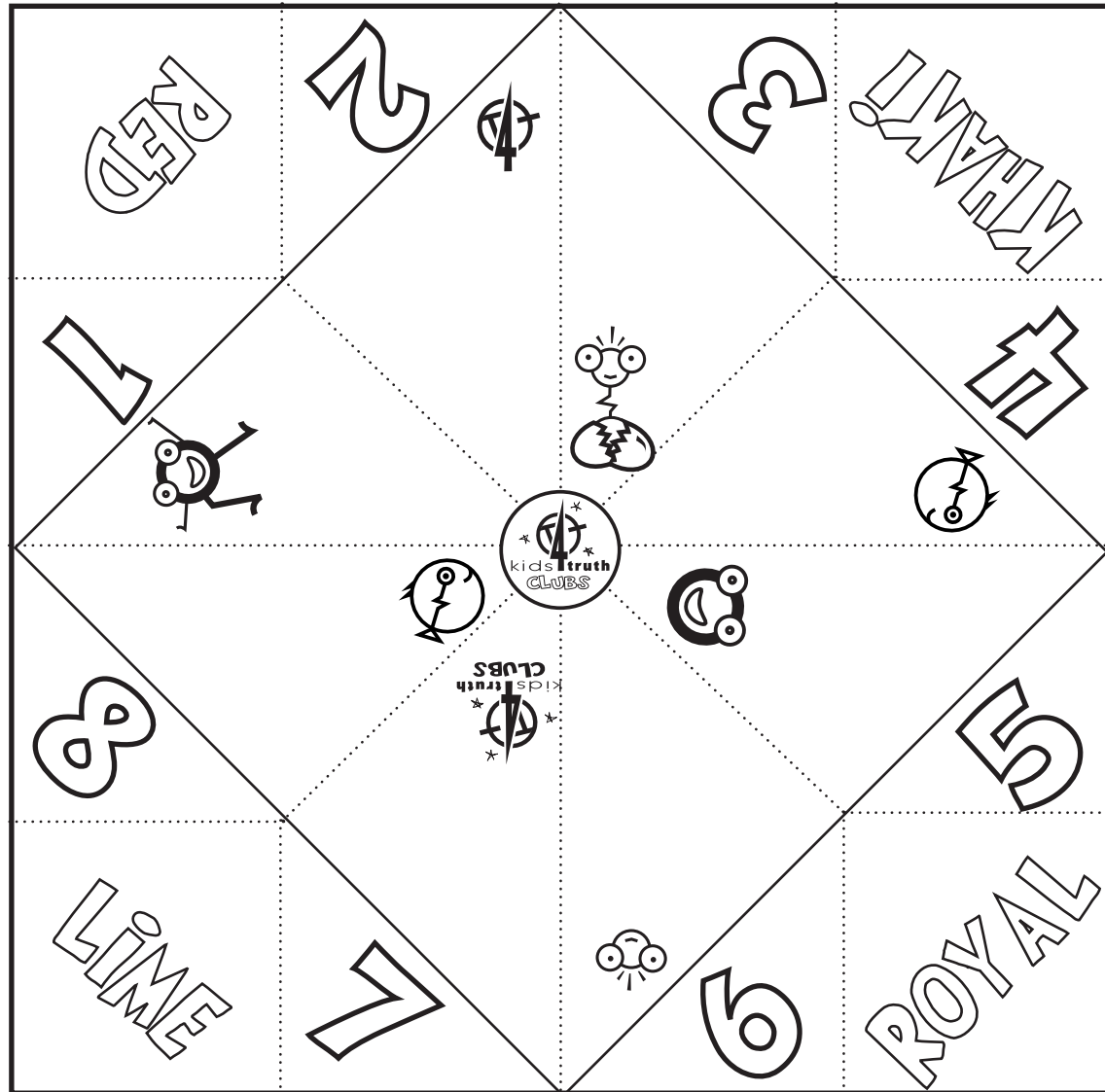
